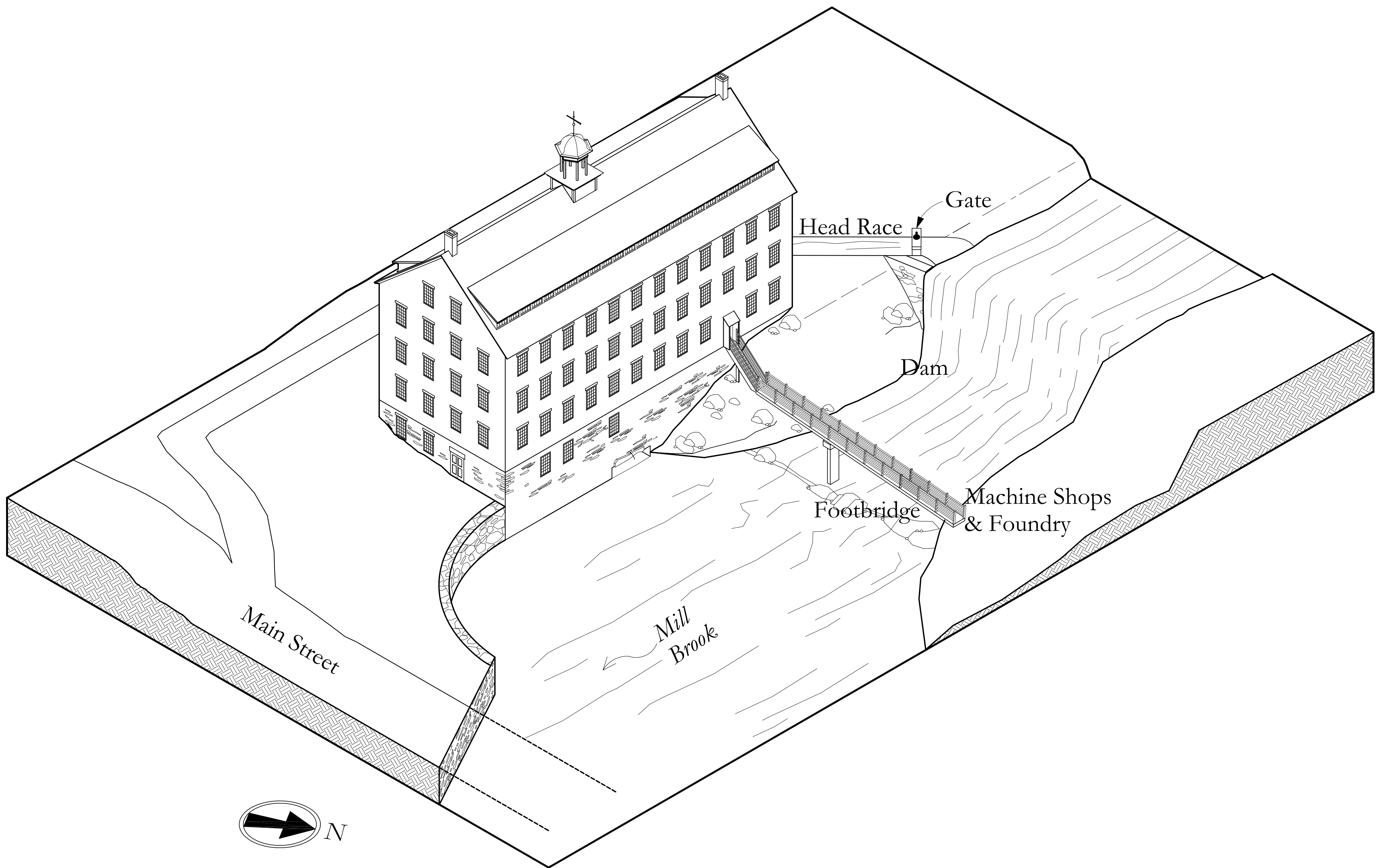


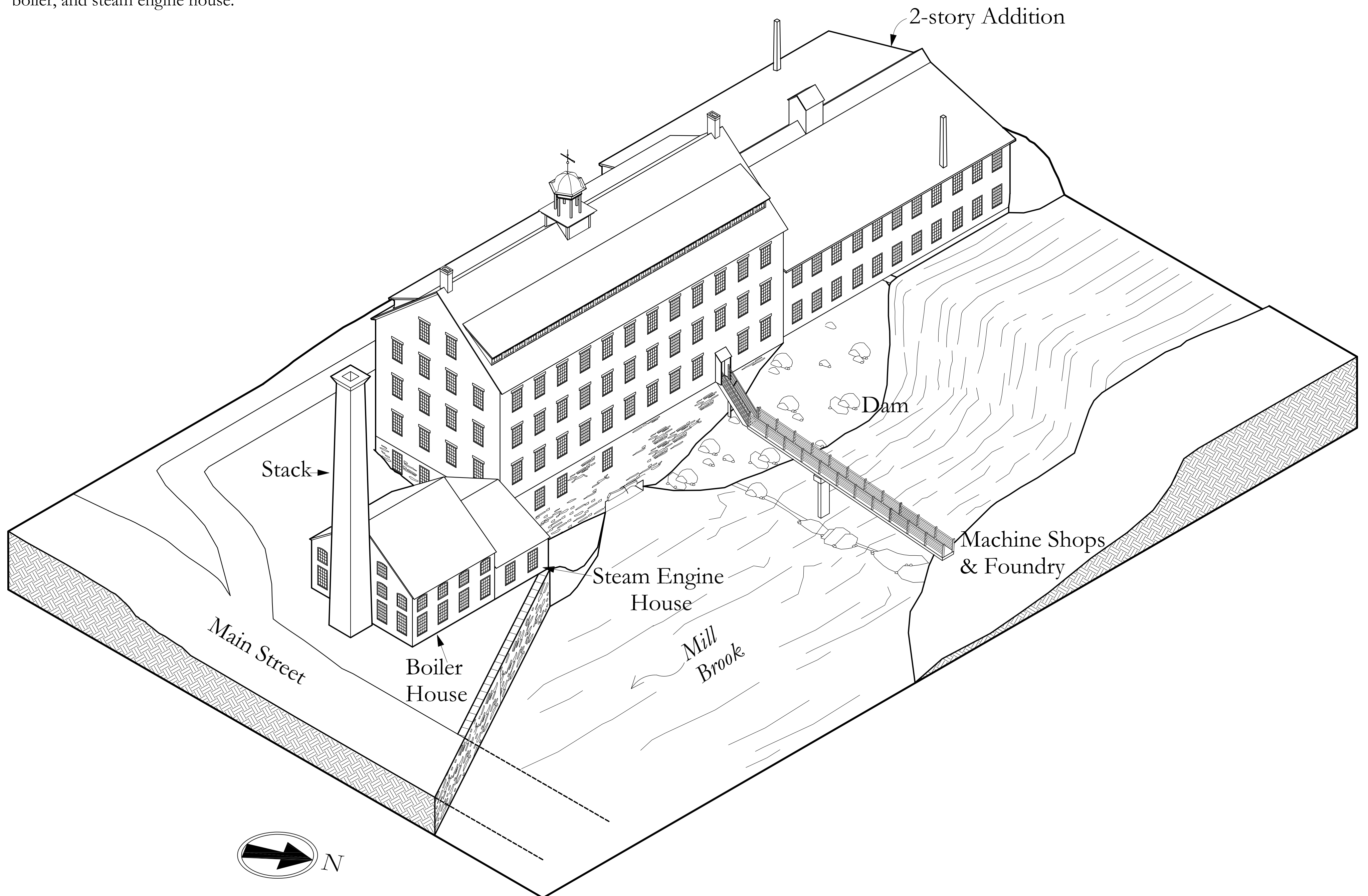
1846 Robbins & Lawrence Armory
